SADDLE HORSE CLASSES

Saddle Horse competitors may purchase a day pass for \$15.00 per horse and rider combination, which enables them to compete in Ring 1 or 2 with the exception of Pony Club Classes. Individual event tickets may be purchased at a cost of \$2.00 per event for Rings 1 & 2. Pony Club Ring competitors may purchase a day pass for \$10.00 per horse and rider combination or individual tickets per event they wish to enter at \$2.00 per event, all Pony Club riders must present for a gear check before their first class and must provide Membership Cards.

POST ENTRIES – Close 15 minutes prior to each class.

EXHIBITORS/COMPETITORS must be current members of the Penola PA & H Society Inc. or pay double entry fee & gate admission each time they enter the show grounds.

Entry Fee in each class includes insurance levy.

SECTION REGULATIONS

1. *Member subscriptions to be paid prior to show or at time of entry.*
2. **Membership fees:** Single – \$15.00, Junior – \$8.00, Family (2 Adults, 3 Children under 18 years) – \$25; includes ground admission for holder of membership card.
3. **Entry Fees:** Include GST. All exhibitors, whether they are registered or not, are to pay the full amount as stated in the schedule. To claim GST you must submit your ABN number when lodging your entries.
NO ENTRY FEES REFUNDED under any circumstances.
4. **Prizemoney & Trophies:** All prizes in this section are offered in terms of general regulations of the Society.
 - Prize money does not include GST. GST will be added to the prize money for exhibitors who are registered for GST and have provided an ABN.
 - Ribbons to 3rd place in Sections D1, D2, D3, D4, D5 & D7 and to 4th place in D6.
 - Unless specially recommended by the judge/s, 2nd & 3rd prize money will not be awarded in classes in which competitors are less than three in number.
 - Show jumping – only 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize money will be awarded in classes in which competitors are less than six in number.
5. **Disqualification:** - Any competitor failing to enter the ring by the third call.
 - Incurred if gear breaks to the extent that the rider cannot carry on.
6. **Attire:** - Riders must wear approved boots & head gear at all times when mounted.
 - Hunting, riding or correct attire must be worn unless otherwise stated in the program.

7. **Certificates:** - Birth certificate to be produced if requested by ring steward in specified age classes.
- Registration certificates & performance cards must be produced if requested by judge or steward (Melbourne & Adelaide certificates accepted.)
8. **Stallions** are not eligible for saddle classes (ring events).
9. **No horse** will be permitted to enter the show ring with any prize ribbon affixed to any portion of the horse, rider or equipment except in parades.
10. **All showjumping events** to be run under FEI & EA rules.
11. **SWABBING:** As per FEI & EA rules.
12. **PROTESTS:** Must be lodged in writing & with a deposit of \$50 with the secretary within 30 minutes of the event. The decision of the Disputes Committee (President, Chief Steward & one Board Member) will be final.
13. Stewards have the power to alter and/or delete classes at their discretion.
14. Should any competitor/exhibitor or other person acting for them nominate the same horse and/or rider in different classes that may clash, they do so at their own risk as classes will not be delayed waiting for them to enter.
15. Cruelty to any animals on the McCorquindale Park grounds during the events held by the Penola PA&H Society will not be tolerated. You will be asked to leave the grounds if you cannot abide by this regulation.

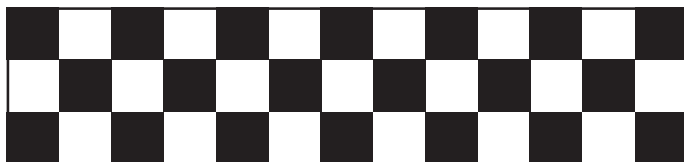
